CV Dr Silvia Ferazzi

Manager, Donor Governments Team, at the Global Fund to fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria

Silvia Ferazzi is leading the team that is responsible for resource mobilization activities with donor governments at the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria.

She graduated in Politics at the University of Turin, she holds a Philosophy Doctorate in Sociology from the University of Pavia, Italy, and has been Post-Doctoral Research Fellow at the University of Bath, UK.

She started her career as a social policy researcher and NGO activist in Italy. Since 1995, she has been holding various positions in the UN system. Before her current assignment, she was advisor on strategy development, partnerships and donor relations in WHO (country follow-up to the work of the Commission on Macroeconomics and Health). Her previous professional experience in the UN system, from 1995 to 2002, focused on inter-agency and donors coordination issues in humanitarian crises, with the WHO Department of Emergency and Humanitarian Action, the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs and the Office of the Deputy Special Representative of the UN Secretary-General in Kosovo.
