Jang Jin-sung is founder and director of New Focus International. As a former counterintelligence officer (United Front Department) and poet laureate for North Korean dictator Kim Jong-il, Jang has unparalleled insights into the heart of the workings of the DPRK. Post-exile, he worked as a senior research fellow at the Institute for National Security Strategy (National Intelligence Service) in Seoul, South Korea. His memoir, Dear Leader, was published by Random House (UK/Worldwide) and Simon & Schuster (US/Canada) in May 2014.

Choe Ju-hwal is North Korea's highest-ranking military defector. Choe served as Deputy Director in the People's Armed Forces (PAF) Foreign Relations Bureau, which is the central institutional arm of the military. He also served as the Military Attaché in the DPRK embassy in Czechoslovakia for four years and led several North Korean military delegations to the USSR. Post-exile, he has worked as a research fellow at the Institute for National Security Strategy (National Intelligence Service) in Seoul, South Korea.
