Dear Ms Roswall and Mr Séjourné,

Please find enclosed the reports from the House of Representatives of the Netherlands on

- 1) the upcoming revision of the REACH regulation, scheduled for March 2026
- 2) the policy area of Circular economy, for which an EU Circular economy act is due by the end of next year.

The reports are written in Dutch, but have also been translated into English.¹

The upcoming revision of REACH is a priority EU policy dossier of the standing committee on Infrastructure and Water management, in anticipation of which two rapporteurs have been appointed: MP Ines Kostić (Party for the animals) and (now former) MP Marieke Koekkoek (Volt). As part of their rapporteurship, MP Kostić paid a work visit to Brussels on June 30th, 2025, during which she also handed over a letter from the Dutch parliament within the context of a political dialogue.²

Circular economy is also a priority dossier within the committee on Infrastructure and Water management. Rapporteurs Geert Gabriëls (former MP of the Green Left-Labour Party) and Martijn Buijsse (former MP of the People's Party for Freedom and Democracy) published their report in September 2025. On December 3rd, 2025, newly elected MPs Dion Huidekooper (Democrats 66) and Jantine Zwinkels (Christian Democratic Appeal) were appointed as new circular economy rapporteurs.
