1. Legal framework and actors



Dutch electoral legislation



The Dutch electoral legislation has been laid down in a number of documents:

The **Constitution** provides especially for the right to vote and to stand for election, and for any applicable exceptions and restrictions.

The **Elections Act** provides for the elections of members to the First and Second Chamber of Parliament, the Electoral College for non-residents, the European Parliament, the provincial council, water management boards and municipal councils. In the Caribbean: island councils and electoral colleges for the First Chamber of parliament.



Ministry of the Interior and the Electoral Council

Electoral Council (Kiesraad)

- Central electoral committee
Responsible for:
 - Tabulation of the election results
 - Candidacy
- Advisory college
- *(from 1-1-26: election authority responsible for quality improvement and support of municipalities)*

Ministry of the Interior

- Responsible for:
 - Electoral law and policy making
 - Voter communication and information
 - (until 1-1-26: support of municipalities in organization of elections)
 - Resilience and functioning of the democratic system



Organisation of the election is decentralised

The Netherlands has 342 municipalities and 3 public entities in the Carib. Municipalities and public entities are responsible for the organisation of the elections.

Responsibilities of the municipalities:

- › Determining who is eligible to vote.
- › Printing and distributing voting cards.
- › Determining locations for polling stations.
- › Selection and training of polling staff.
- › Determining election outcome within the municipality.
- › Forwarding the outcome to the relevant Central Electoral Committee.





2. Political parties and candidates



Political parties

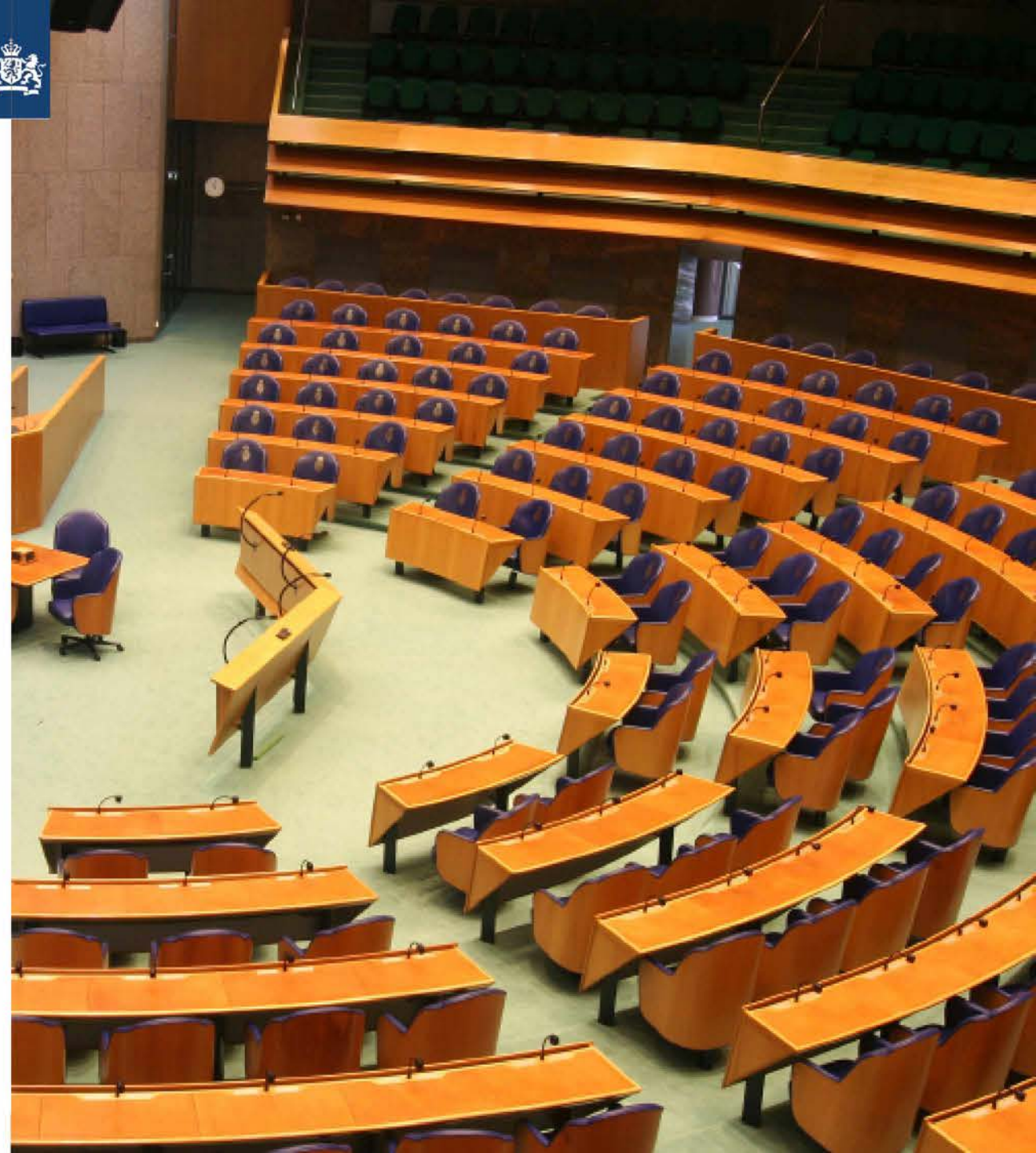
- Last election (2023) **26 political parties** were participating.
- In comparison in 2021 there were 37 political parties.
- There are 20 electoral districts for candidacy and determining election results.
- Not all parties participate in every electoral district.
- For now we don't know how many parties are participating.
- 15 September is the day of candidature





Candidates

- 150 candidates will be elected
- Maximum allowed number of candidates per party differs:
 - If a political party currently does not have seat in the Second chamber or has 15 seats or less > a maximum of 50 candidates.
 - If a political party currently has 16 seats or more in the Second Chamber > a maximum of 80 candidates.
- Candidates must be 18 years or older, have the Dutch nationality and their right to be elected cannot have been revoked by a court order.

Voter eligibility for the Second Chamber elections

- › More than 13 million people are eligible to vote for election for the dutch representatives in the European Parliament.
- › Citizens are eligible to vote for these elections if:
 - They have reached the age of 18 on election day;
 - They are a Dutch national and
 - Their right to vote hasn't been revoked by a court order.
- › Voter turnout for this election:
 - 2023: 77,7%
 - 2021: 78,71%
 - 2017: 81,57%
 - 2012: 74,57%

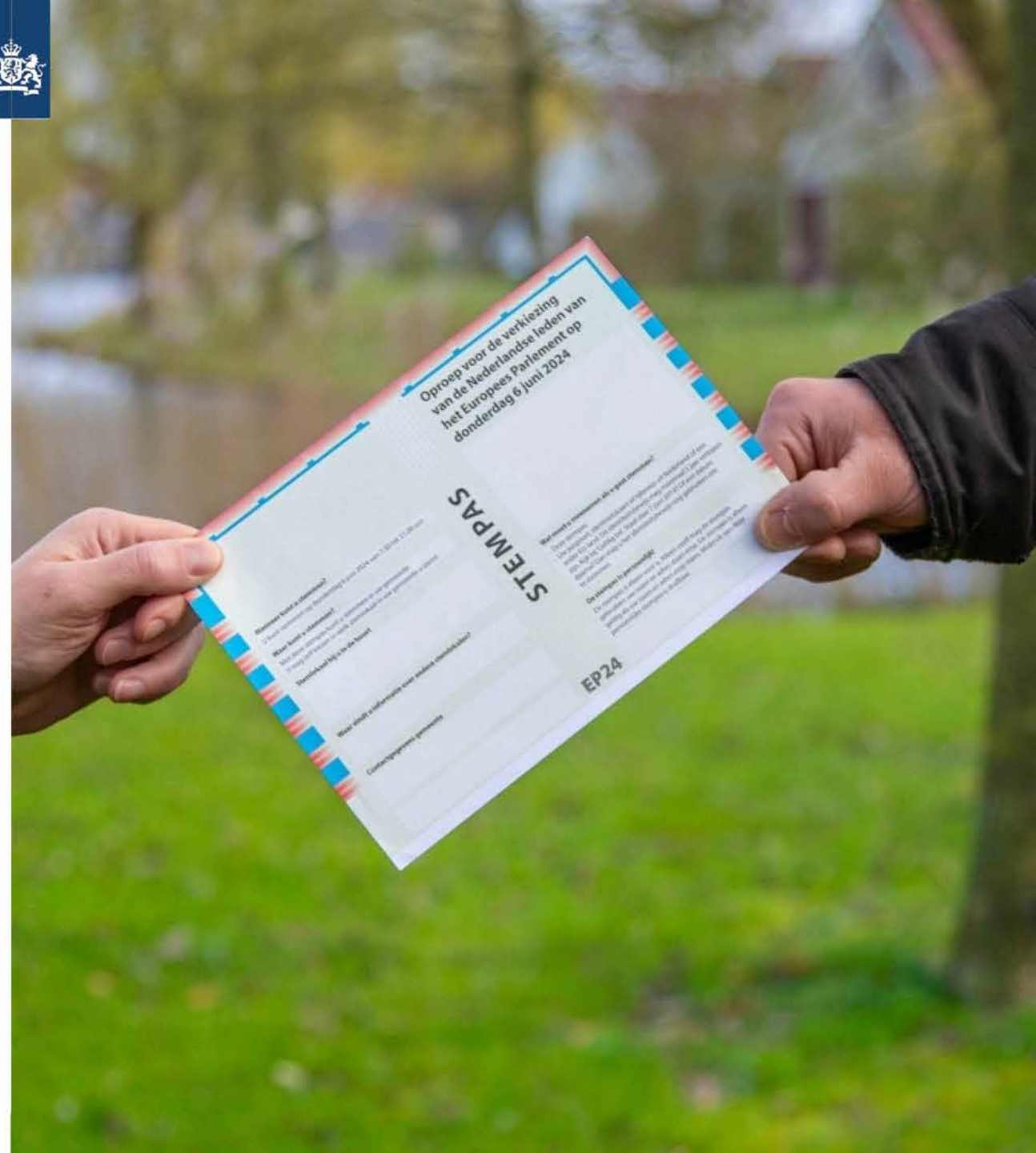

Voting by proxy

- › In the Netherlands, approximately 10% of the votes are cast by proxy.
- › The maximum number of proxy votes is 2 per person per election.
- › There is an initiative bill pending on early voting in combination with lowering the number of proxy votes to 1.
- › A new law tightening the criminalization of recruiting proxies is now pending in the Senate. The law aims to end abuse and the risk of influencing and manipulating voting behaviour through proxy canvassing.





Voters abroad

Types of polling stations

- Regular polling stations (07.30AM-09.00PM)
- Regular polling stations with different counting locations (07.30AM-09.00PM)
- Special polling stations (divergent opening hours)
- Mobile polling stations





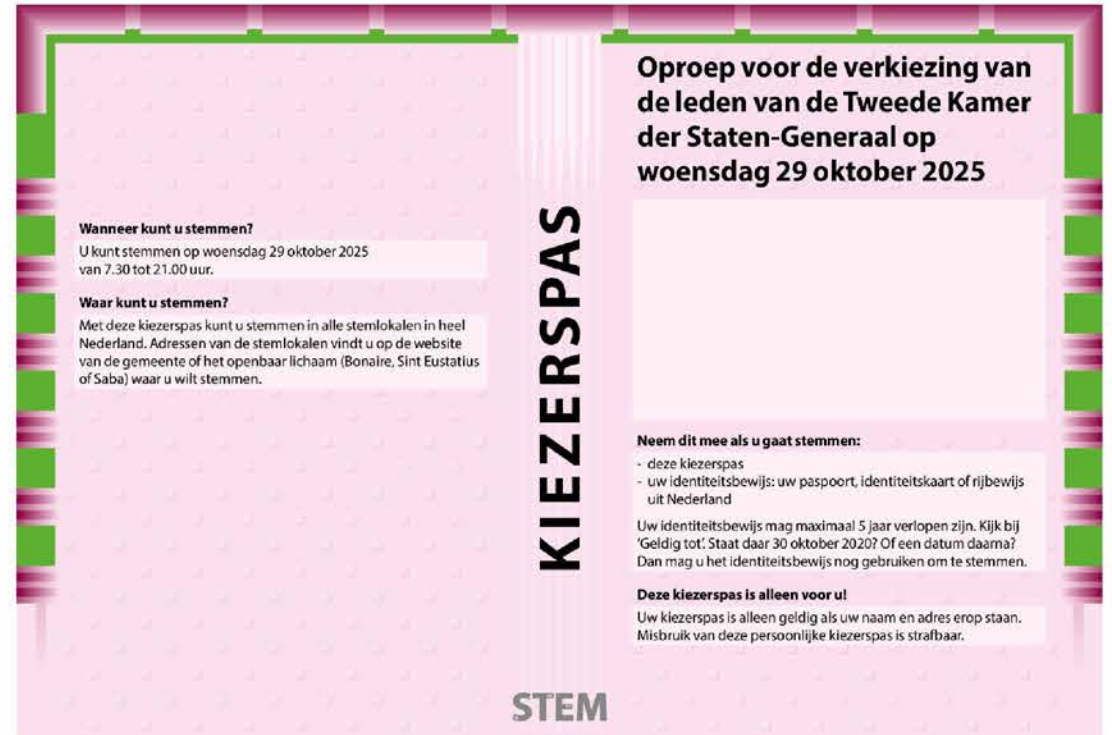
Process of voting

Every voter receives a voting pass at home.

The electoral committee checks the voting pass and identification.

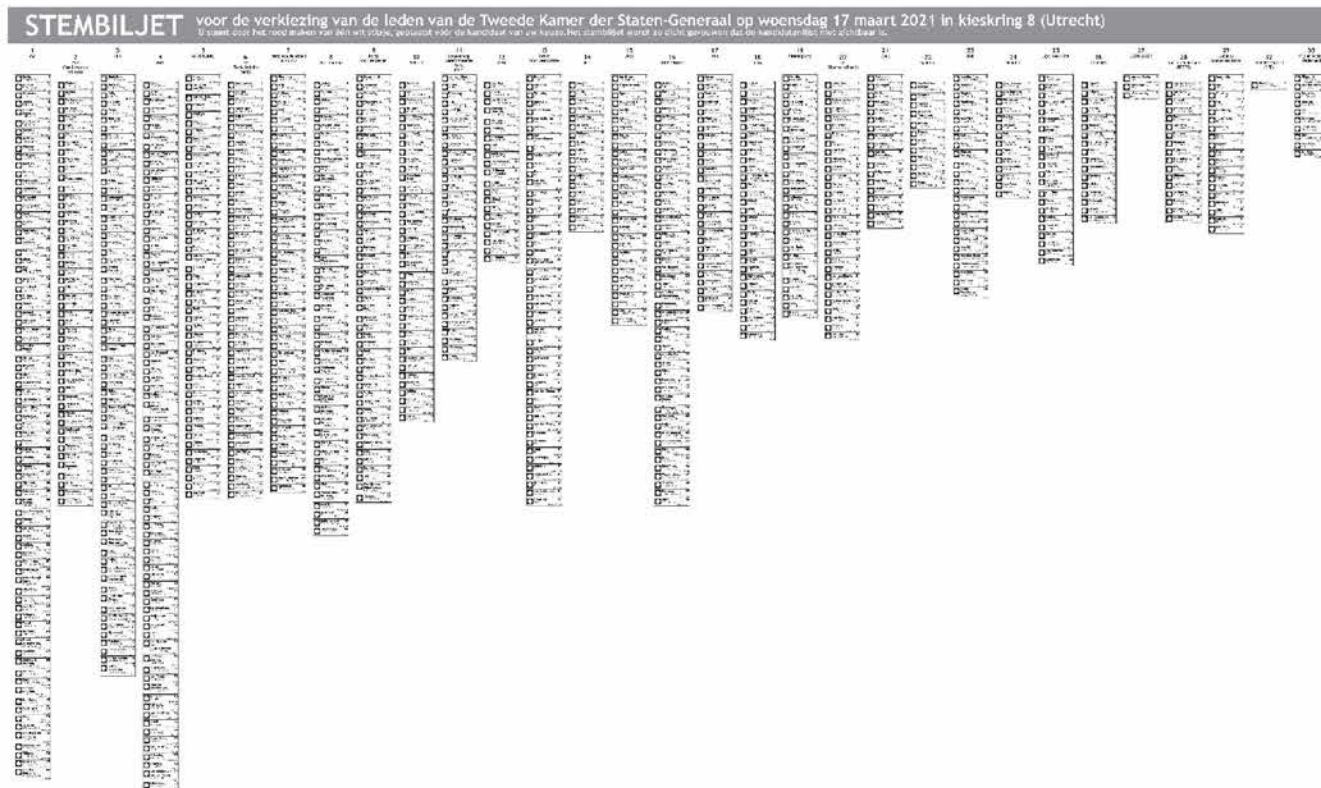
And checks the register of invalid voting passes.

The voter receives a ballot paper to cast a vote.





Ballot paper

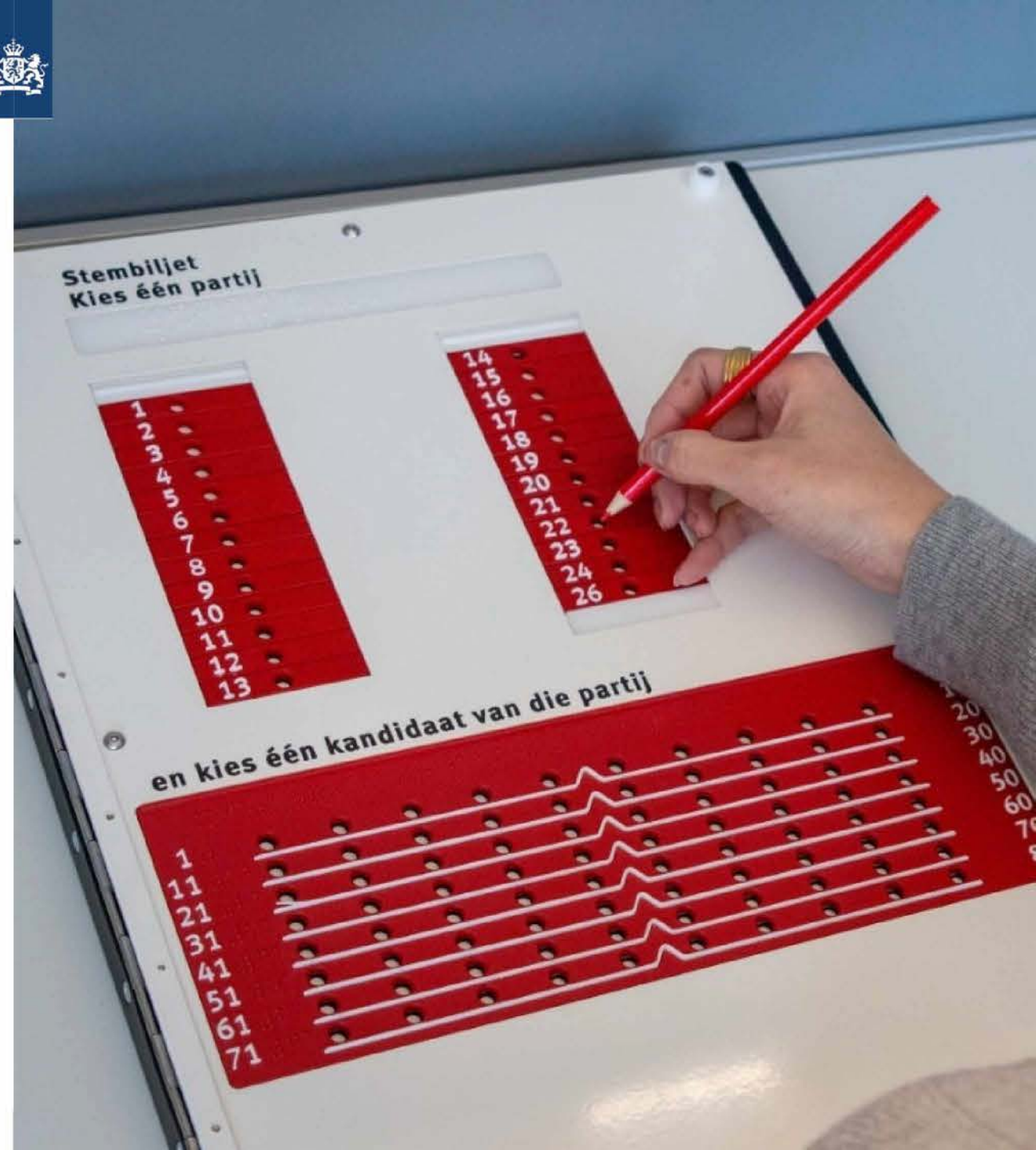


- An example of a ballot paper.
- The ballot paper contains all the political parties and candidates.
- 70cm x 50cm.
- Experiment with a new model ballot paper.



Experiment with new ballot paper

- › Second experiment in five municipalities:
 - › Alphen aan den Rijn
 - › Boekel
 - › Borne
 - › Midden-Delfland
 - › Tynaarlo
- › As this is a by-election, no additional municipalities will be added to the experiment.
- › 40cm x 30cm

5. Counting



Counting the votes

- Counting manual by electoral committee in the polling stations and by municipal electoral committee.
- Report for each polling station.
- Municipal results and reports are published online as soon as possible.
- Checks by central electoral committee.
- If checks lead to a recount and corrections, a report will be published online.
- Public hearing municipal electoral committee and central electoral committee.
