Excellency,

As you will recall the United Nations deployed an expert monitoring mission (the mission) at the invitation of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to Sint Eustatius for the Island's referendum on 17 December 2014.

The mission assessed the general referendum preparations in Sint Eustatius, reviewing the various aspects of the referendum process, and monitored voting at the polling location.

The mission found the referendum to be technically sound; voting and counting procedures broadly meeting international best practice with few ballots declared invalid. A 60% threshold instituted by the Island Council to establish a valid process was not met (turnout was 45.4% of registered voters). Nonetheless, the mission assessed voter intention was clear and not challenged.

The mission received a number of complaints from civil society and voters. These included concerns that the public information campaign preceding the referendum was too short and messaging at times confusing or contradictory. Voter reregistration issues related to the need to have a Kingdom issued voter card to vote were also raised in addition to allegations that the voters list itself was inadequate for the purpose (duplications, deceased voters, etcetera). While the mission is of the opinion that some concerns were legitimate, they probably did not meaningfully affect the outcome of this referendum.


As the mission was not an observer mission, the United Nations will not be making any public statement/judgment on the conduct or outcome of the referendum.
